Read Mark 5:25-29

Question #4 This woman speaks of just needing to touch Jesus' cloak to be healed. Why was she get to that place of desperation and faith?

Read Mark 5:30-34

Question #5 Jesus takes the time to stop and find the woman who had touched his cloak, who had been healed. What does this tell us?
