Key Scriptures: *Mark 6:45-56; John 6:14-15*

Read Mark 6:45-46; John 6:14-15

Question #3 How does what John wrote change our understanding of Mark dismissing the 2 groups?

Read Mark 6:47-50

Question #4 Have you ever been completely lost/ disoriented in a storm? How did it feel? What was it like?

Question #5 The disciples were straining against the oars for 9 hours. Straining against the wind and the storm for 9 hours before they saw Jesus. How can this apply to our lives?

Read Mark 6:50-52

Question #6 Jesus did not walk past the disciples, but instead came to the boat and got in. The Greek actually says; Jesus desired to come alongside them. How does this relate to us? What does it look like today?
