INTO THE BIBLE

Key Scriptures: Genesis 11:1-9; Acts 2:1-13; Acts 2:14-21; Ephesians 5:18-20

Read Genesis 11:1-9 and then read Acts 2:1-13

Question #3 What do these two passages show us about Pentecost and the coming of the Holy Spirit?

Question #4 What does that mean for us/ how does it apply to us?

Read Acts 2:14-21

Question #5 What changed for Peter between his denial of Christ at Easter and the day of Pentecost?

Question #6 What encouragement does that provide for us today?

Read Ephesians 5:18-20

In this passage Paul is addressing Christians, people who were given the Holy Spirit at the time of conversion and he is calling for them to be filled again.

Question #7 Is this idea of being filled again and needing to continually be seeking to be filled by the Spirit of God a new idea for you or one you have known before?

DIGGING DEEPER:

Question #8 What does it look like, and how do we get filled by the Holy Spirit?
